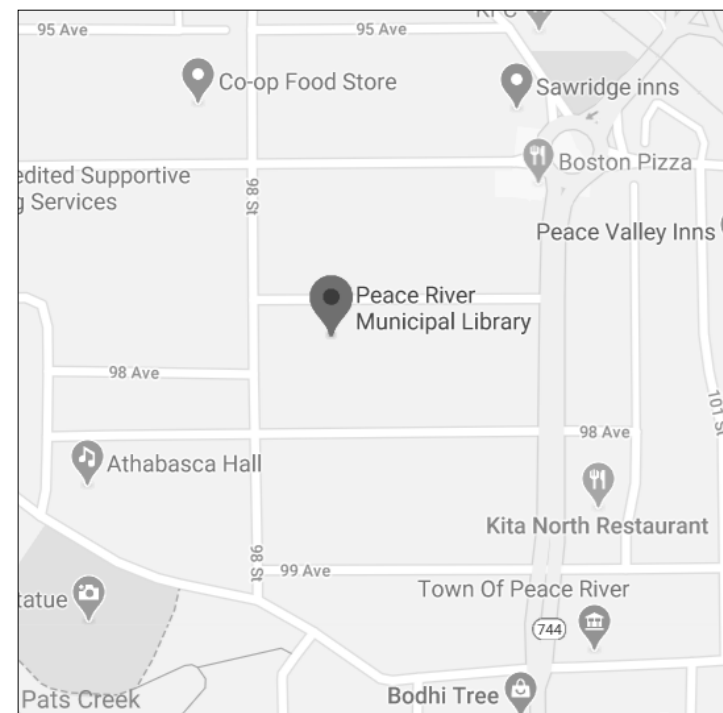
Library cards must be renewed annually.

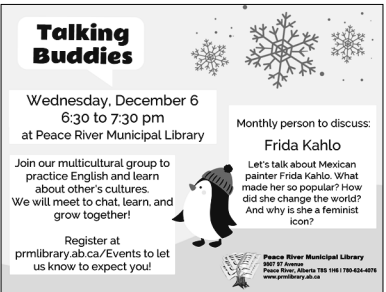


## Mongoose’s Traveller:
