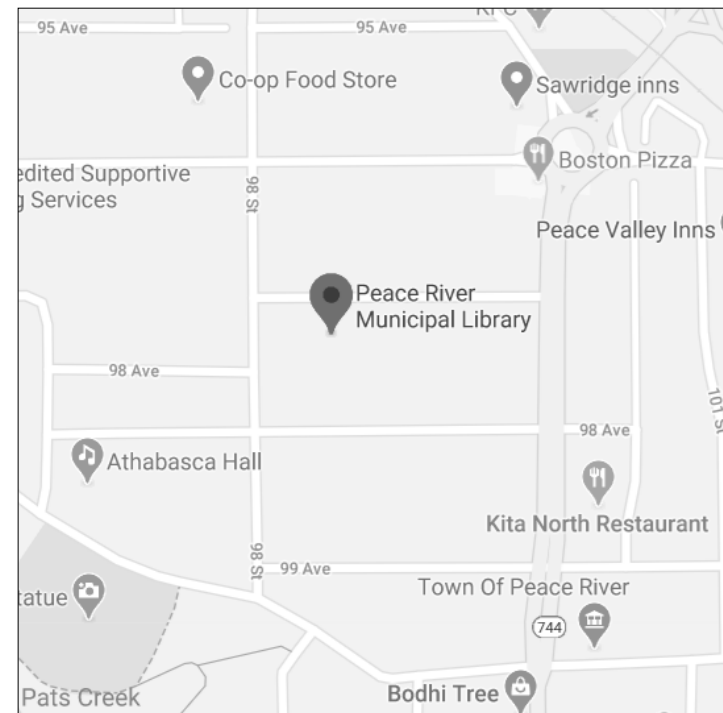
Library cards must be renewed annually.

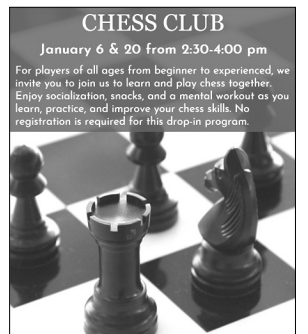
## Dungeons and Dragons:
