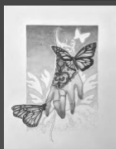


## *Permanence of Ink Art Show*

Make your own paper penguin. You can take it home or hang it in our winter display!

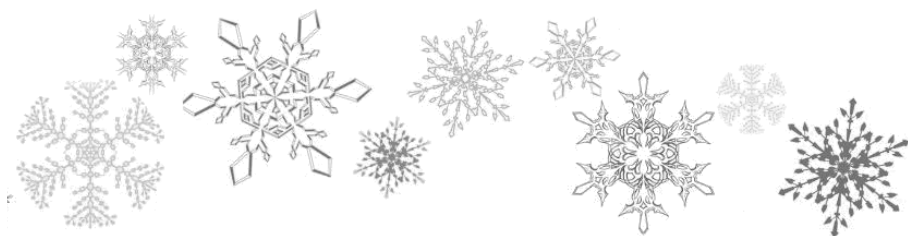


### Maker Station 3: Adult Colouring

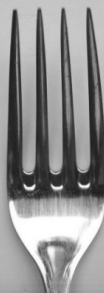

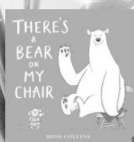
## Story Time

## Computers & Internet

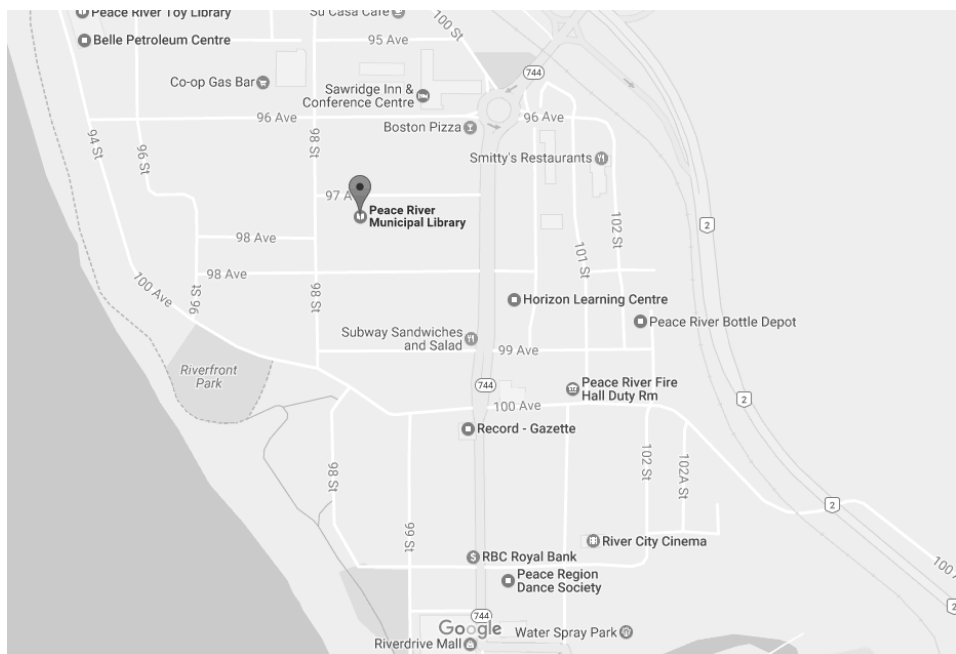
We have 7 computers connected to the internet. Free for the public to use. Must check in at Circulation Desk. Limited to 2 hours per day.
