1) Twelve Foot Davis Statue:

As you embark come and see Twelve Foot Davis; drop by the park!



2) Treaty Eight Monument:

Surrounded by a flagpole lining, this monument commemorates a significant signing.



3) Dr. W Greene Cairn:

Built for a doctor, a dentist, and an engineer, Dr. Greene's cairn is a place to enjoy nature, and maybe even see some deer!



4) Twelve Foot Davis Gravesite:

At his one request, Mr. Davis' bones rest overlooking the beautiful valley that his heart loved best.



5) Cecil Thompson Park

Complete with a bouncy pillow, campsites, and a fishing pond, this is the place you and your friends will want to come to bond.



6) Sagitawa Lookout:

Named for where 3 rivers meet, this is the perfect spot to take a break and eat.



7) Twelve Foot Davis Events

Once a baseball diamond, now an outdoor events venue, this is a great park no matter what you plan to do!



8) Peace River Museum:

Within these walls history lies. Have you ever been? You should try!

9) Peace River 100th Murals:

10) Mackenzie Cairn:

Built to overlook a long lost Fort, this cairn sees where the rivers fork.
